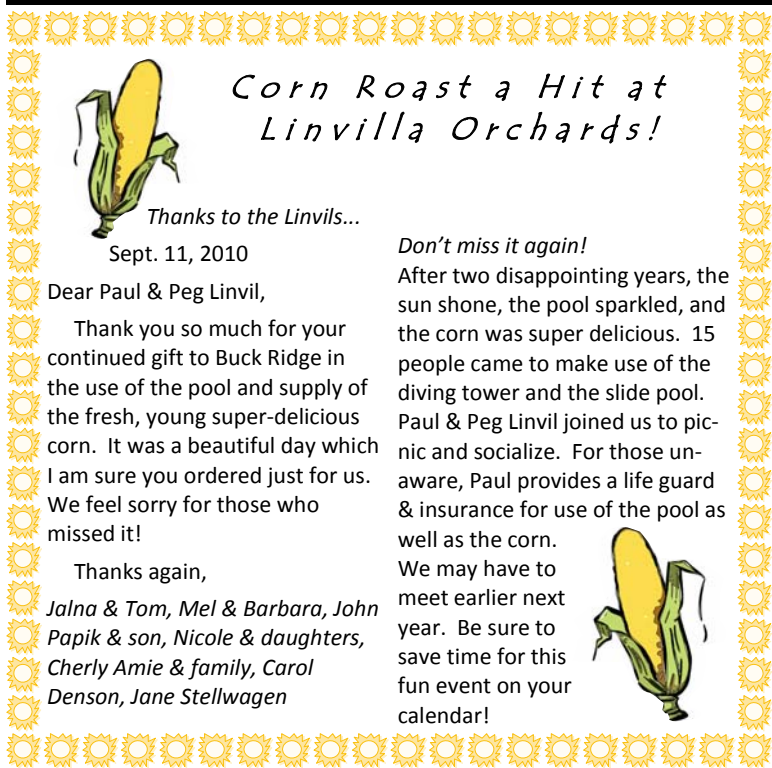

We had a good turnout for the formal introduction of the new season's ski schedule. Some things to keep in mind as we move into ski season:

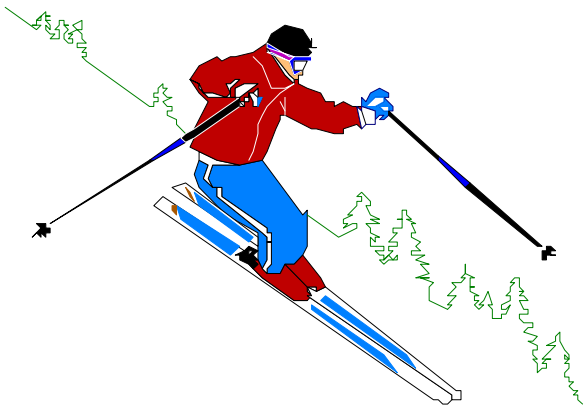

FALL 2010 WOODBRIDGE LODGE WORK / CLEANING PARTY: OCTOBER 22-24

Space is limited—contact Glenn Weisel to confirm your attendance! We will arrive on Friday, Depart Sunday. Everyone gets 2 chits per full day worked not to exceed 2 days per person for this 2010 work party. Each chit is worth one night's lodging good thru the 2012 ski season. Work party starts Saturday morning and ends Sunday afternoon. Anyone extending their stay past two nights may do so with a reservation or chits from previous work parties.

Plan to bring along cereal or whatever you want for breakfast. Either we will have a chef or we will do our own food prep while working. More info will be provided later. We will be dividing the food costs among the adult members of our work party as in previous years.

The "To Do" List:

1. general yard clean up
2. screens up into storage position and storm windows installed
3. wash all windows inside and out
4. install clear polyethylene plastic sheeting stretched over outside of two kitchen windows.
5. Replace batteries in ALL smoke alarms and CO2 alarms, check basement gas alarm
6. Replace light bulbs as needed
7. Remove all mattress covers, take to laundromat in Wilmington, wash, dry, return and reinstall.
8. General cleaning of lodge interior includes pulling appliances out, cleaning and resetting units.
9. Cleaning of range hoods, filters, bath and shower fans
10. Clean shower drain traps
11. Replace furnace filter
12. Clean and check operation of sump pump
13. Troubleshoot and fix outdoor lights
14. Assess condition of front outdoor stairway and make plans for future replacement -- prefab stairway at home and haul up to the lodge, assemble and install at a future work party
15. Paint front door
16. Caulk around new lower kitchen window – outside
17. Remove original setting caulk from bathroom sink perimeters, recaulk using white 100% silicone
18. Replace pop up drain assembly in third bath sink
19. Replace drawer front in lower kitchen
20. Install new hardware on double hung hall and upstairs bedroom windows
21. Polyurethane door between living room and ski room
22. Clean out under building and reassess the fallen pillar project for a future work party
23. Clean out basement and ski room closet, take trash to the dump

Trip Includes: Round-trip air on American Airlines between Philadelphia and Jackson, with ground transfers to and from the hotel, 7 nights lodging at the relaxing Parkway Inn, 5-of-6-day lift ticket, welcome reception on arrival night, deluxe continental breakfast each morning, baggage handling.

Flights are subject to change and departure delays. Baggage check fees are additional and will be paid at the airport each way. Currently American is charging \$15 for the first piece of luggage and \$25 for the second, with a ski bag and boot bag still being counted as one bag. Overweight items (50 lb+) will incur significant additional expense. You can accrue frequent flyer miles with the ticket by providing your membership number to airline staff at check-in. **Note:** Tickets are name specific; if for some reason you must cancel but can get a replacement, you will still be liable for a change fee of up to \$175 after February 1, 2010.

The Parkway Inn: Situated on a quiet street just 3 blocks from Jackson Hole's Historic Town Square and a short shuttle bud ride to the slopes, The Parkway Inn offers a relaxing stay close to all that Jackson has to offer. From the "local color" of the Town Square's elk antler arches to the unique shops and restaurants along the boardwalks, Jackson truly has something for everyone. Enjoy amazing views of the mountains as they rise from the valley floor to over 12,000 feet above you. You will enjoy seeing wildlife as diverse as Elk, Moose, Bald Eagles and Osprey as you ski, dine and shop in "The Hole." It is a few minutes drive from Grand Teton National Park and Jackson Hole Elk Preserve, and an hour from Yellowstone National Park and Grand Targhee ski resort. The Parkway Inn features:

No lift tickets – deduct \$300; Sr age 65 and up - deduct \$60; No airfare - deduct \$400. You can arrange a day-trip to Grand Targhee for approx. \$100 pp from the hotel; you should plan on this as a 6th day or get a 4 of 6 day ticket for Jackson and deduct the appropriate amount; details will be made available at a later date for this option.
