Annual Hunt for Snow

CLUB NEWS & NOTES

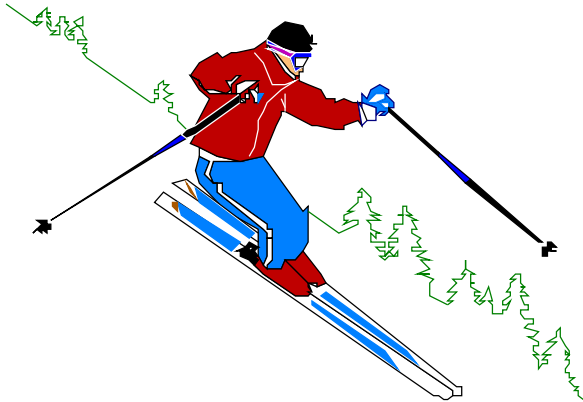
The following are items of note from recent Board meetings:

If you don't use your 6 visits by February 21st, remaining days can be used anytime including weekends. You can arrive at your leisure and just present your pass at the gate Monday through Thursday. A Prepaid-Multi-Visit Lift Only Pass is only \$98.00 this year, averaging to \$16.34 per visit. The rate for a regular one day lift ticket 8:30am – 10pm from Blue Mountain's Ticket Window is \$55.00, so the Prepaid-Multi-Visit package is very economical.

Join Buck Ridge Ski Club's European trip which takes us to the BRAND NEW destination of Cortina D'Ampezzo "Queen of the Dolomites", a world-famous winter resort that rivals any other in the Alps. Encircled by massive peaks that rise nearly 9,843 feet above the village, Cortina boasts four mountain passes, encompassing 70 miles of runs on many separate ski complexes, including Cristallo, Faloria, Mietres, Tofana and Lagazuoi/Cinque Torri with free shuttle buses linking the areas.
