## PROJECTS-----

### PLUMBING

1. Replace toilet in bathroom 1
2. Clean shower traps
3. Replace water heater ( Please direct questions on the water heater project to Mel Stiles )

### ELECTRIC

1. Replace control for exterior parking lot light
2. Replace three way switches controlling ski room lights
3. Install receptacle and telephone jack for new low temperature alarm
4. Rework electric box in lower kitchen attic -- old brittle wires to be cut back , install junction box(s) and new lead wires
5. Install and program low temperature alarm

### PAINTING

1. Pressure wash and stain front stairway , back porch , woodshed and entrance stairway
2. Sand and polyurethane bunk ladders
3. Paint new bathroom and shower room doors
4. Paint water heater closet door and trim
5. Paint new window trim

## GENERAL MAINTENANCE

1. Clean out attics , inventory and haul junk to the dump
2. Major yard clean up with gas powered weedwackers , rake lawn , etc
3. Remove fire extinguishers , take home for service and replace at the October work party.
4. Carefully clean refrigerator condensers
5. Oil rollers on woodshed doors , repair as needed
6. Install aluminum capping on exterior window trim -- new lower kitchen window
7. Caulk around window
8. Insulate lower kitchen attic

## CARPENTRY

1. Finish latticework around foundation perimeter.
  2. Install wood trim on lower kitchen window
  3. Install wall tile in new lower kitchen
  4. Install small countertop and vertical filler to right of range in new lower kitchen
  5. Install small drawer in lower kitchen cabinet
  6. Make and install two doors over the water heater closet door
  7. Replace 5 doors in lower kitchen / bath area , hinges and knobs
  8. Make new operating window unit with insulated glass , screen and weatherstripping for basement ----- leave open with screen in the summer and close in the winter
  9. Install wire shelving units on back of ski room closet doors
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## Fall 2007 Cleaning Work Party    Dates to be determined

1. General yard clean up
2. Receive and stack firewood delivery
3. Replace smoke detector batteries
4. Reinstall recharged fire extinguishers
5. Gas appliance service ----- main heater only
6. Fill liquid soap dispensers
7. Remove , clean , and reinstall bath and shower room exhaust fans
8. Replace light bulbs as required
9. Store summer screens in attic and install winter glass storm panel in storm door
10. Clean windows
11. Remove , clean and reinstall grease filters in range hood and microwave unit.
12. Clean Chimney
13. Wash and reinstall mattress covers
14. General overall cleaning of lodge interior
